As you will know, parents evening for S2 takes place next week. You are invited to make appointments for our S2 Parents Evening on **Thursday 20th January**. Parent-teacher meetings will run from 4:30-6:30PM, will be booked online, and then held by telephone call rather than inperson at the school.

To make your appointments please login at: <u>https://parents-booking.co.uk/smithycroft</u> Enter the school name - **Smithycroft** - or the postcode (G33 2QU) to get started.

To login you will need to enter:

- Your first name and surname
- Your child's first name, surname, and date of birth

The login details you enter <u>must</u> match those we have on record for you.

Appointments will be available to book from Friday 14th

January until midday (12pm) on Wednesday 19th January. After you have made your appointments you can choose to print or e-mail a confirmation. You can re-login at the website address above to view your schedule at any time after booking.

On the day of your appointments, your child's teachers will call you at the scheduled time using the contact information we have on record. If you need to provide a new number, or if you are unsure if the information we have is accurate, you will be able to provide contact details during the booking process. You will have 5 minutes with each teacher you book an appointment with. It is important that your meeting does not run over the allotted 5 minutes, so we advise you to prepare any questions you may have in advance.
